After a joking altercation with another student and myself, [REDACTED] came up to me and attempted to hit me (I assumed in a joking manner) and I stuck my arm out in the air to deflect and prevent her from actually hitting me. Her forearm hit my forearm and she said "oh no I'm hurt!" with a smile on her face and continued to joke about it throughout the class period. Towards the end of the class period, [REDACTED] approached me in the kitchen and came up again joking around acting like she was going to fight me. She had both of her fists up in a fighting stance and began making motions and gestures as if she was throwing punches at me. When she got to close I grabbed her fist before she connected with me and held her hands telling her that this was enough and to stop playing around. As I was holding her hands and after I said that, she then kicked me in the crotch area. I told her that was not funny and that that really did hurt. She then began to walk off and cry. I approached her and began to tell her that this is why rough housing isn't a good idea and this could have all been avoided had she not continued to put her hands on me. Her demeanor at this point was completely night and day from how she was the rest of the day. She would not talk to me and said she was leaving and continued to grab her things and leave. I did not like how she was acting all of a sudden and wanted to be transparent and clear with her parents about what exactly happened today in class and asked her to please call her mom for me to have a discussion on the phone. Her mom doesn't speak very good English so she asked for me to speak to someone in her family who can translate. I told them the scenario and they thanked me for the call and then I gave [REDACTED] her phone and she left my classroom.
