WHEREAS, in 2022, the City of Arlington received a 100/100 on the Human Rights Campaign's Municipal Equality Index, which demonstrates the ways cities support the LGBTQ+ people who live and work there; and

WHEREAS, while real progress has been made toward acceptance and equality, more work is needed to combat discrimination and prejudice; and

WHEREAS, Arlington is committed to protecting the civil rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities to strengthen our city and to create a solid, unified society where hatred and inequality of any group is unacceptable;

WHEREAS, the second annual LGBTQ+ Pride event in Arlington, co-hosted by the Mayor's LGBTQ Advisory Council and the HELP Center for LBGT Health & Wellness, will be celebrated on June 10, 2023.
