COMES NOW THE STATE OF TEXAS, by and through her Assistant Criminal District Attorney and requests the Court to deny Defendant bond in this case, or alternatively, to increase that bond. As grounds for same, the State would show the Court the following:

This above named defendant is currently charged with the offenses of Assault Family Violence Impeding Breath/Circulation, Assault Family Violence Impeding Breath/Circulation, Assault Peace Officer and Harassment of a Public Servant in cause numbers F2060080, F2152422, F2252164 and F2252165, respectively. For this offense, the defendant is currently on a \$10,000 personal recognizance bond.

Evidence has been forthcoming that persuades the State that the current amount of bond is insufficient and the State believes that there exists good and sufficient cause to hold the current bond insufficient.

On July 5, 2024, the defendant is alleged to have committed the offense of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon in Dallas County in cause number F2476393. As of the afternoon of July 8, 2024, the defendant is being held in jail for this offense. This allegation is in violation of the defendant's bond condition that she "remain arrest free pending disposition of current offense."

Moreover, on July 8, 2024, the defendant is also alleged to have committed the offense of Aggravated Robbery in Dallas Police Department incident report number 24-1230489. This allegation is in violation of the defendant's bond condition that she "not possess a deadly weapon," namely a firearm.

The State is deeply concerned for the safety of both victims and the safety of the community.

Wherefore Presimes Considered, it is respectfully requested that this Court deny Defendant bond in this case, pursuant to Art. 17.15, Tex. C.C.P. In the alternative, the State respectfully requests that this Court find the amount of bond to be insufficient in amount and require Defendant to give another bond in such amount as the Court deems proper, in accordance with Art. 17.09, Sec. 3, Tex. C.C.P.
